5 Reasons You Should Add To Your Toolbox

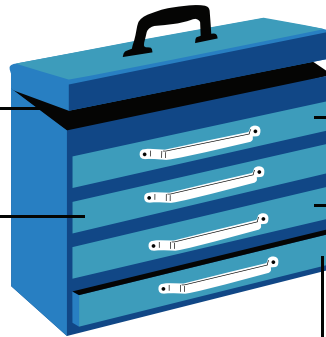
1 Perform your job better.

Develop flexible skill sets so you're not totally shifted off-kilter if management throws you a curveball.

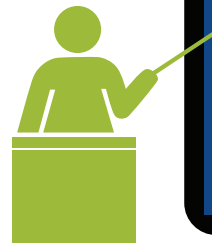
5 Fulfill your quest for personal development.
